- Ultrasound of ankle sprains: detailed analysis of ligamentous structures and a thorough understanding of the mechanisms of injury.
- Effective rotator cuff ultrasound: mastering a rapid, standardised and comprehensive protocol for shoulder examination.
- Ultrasound of chronic calf pain: precise identification of the various muscular, tendinous, aponeurotic and vascular causes.
